For individualized career services, a Career Planner conducts a preliminary assessment of a job seekers' skills, interests, and employment goals and then develops a plan with the job seeker to achieve those goals. There are eligibility and suitability requirements for Individual career services.

# CAREER RESOURCE CENTER (CRC)

The CRC at the PA CareerLink of Somerset County provides multiple resources to assist job seekers with their job search. Inside the CRC you will find desk top computers equipped with high speed internet that may be used for any aspect of the job search process.

Specialized computers with assistive technology are available for use by individuals with hearing, vision or dexterity impairments. In addition to having access to our search engine, pacareerlink.pa.gov, job seekers also have access to other online job search sites, can complete online applications and can create & print resumes, cover letters and thank-you letters.

# ON-THE-JOB-TRAINING (OJT)

#### **PROGRAM PURPOSE**

On-the-job training is designed to provide eligible candidates the knowledge and skills necessary for long-term, meaningful employment. It also provides reimbursement to employers for the extraordinary costs of training individuals who do not possess all of the skills required at the time of hire.

#### **ADVANTAGES to the EMPLOYER**

- Employer reimbursement (maximum of 50%) of training wage; maximum of 960 hours.
- Access to CareerLink's Business Services Coordinator.
- Assistance with recruitment of candidates that meet your needs.
- Employer oversees hiring, employment and discharge decisions.
- Assists PA CareerLink customers found to be eligible for individualized services to gain successful employment and bridges the gap between participant's current skills and skills needed by participating employer.
- Promotes self-sufficient employment and career advancement allowing OJT participants to secure employment with wages equal to, or exceeding, the region's self-sufficiency wage.

### **ADVANTAGES TO JOB SEEKERS**

- OJT participants are treated in the same manner as all other employees including: wages, opportunity for advancement, etc.
- Eligible applicants are trained in a new field without personal financial investment.
- Equal to or exceeding the region's self-sufficiency wage.
- Upon completion of the OJT Program, participants remain full time employees with the company.

# INDIVIDUAL TRAINING ACCOUNT (ITA)

Individual Training Accounts are a form of financial assistance available to PA CareerLink registered customers who are found to be both eligible and suitable for individualized services.

Individuals looking to pursue training after high school/GED with a program a program of 2 years or less in duration may apply.

### **ITA PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

- The course of study and post-secondary institution the individual wishes to attend must be listed on CareerLink's approved provider list. This list is viewable at <a href="https://www.pacareerlink.pa.gov">www.pacareerlink.pa.gov</a> under the "find training" link. The program must also represent a career that is in demand for the Southern Alleghenies region.
- Applicants will take a TABE assessment prior to attending training. These assessments are administered by the PA CareerLink of Somerset County.
- Applicants must apply for PELL and PHEAA where applicable and be able to demonstrate source of funding for any tuition not covered by the ITA.
- Upon approval for funding, the customer's progress will be followed by their assigned career planner throughout the duration of the training and also upon completion of the training.
