Weekly Theme 2: The Always Ask First Rule

Learn

This week children will learn to follow the Always Ask First Rule to keep them safe.

Help children understand:

- They should always ask a parent or the bigger person in charge first:
 - When they're not sure if something is safe.
 - When someone asks them to go somewhere, do something, or give them something.
- Following the Always Ask First Rule helps them stay safe.



Practice

This week, help children practice these skills.

Say:

- Is it safe?
- May I...?
- I have to ask first.
- Always ask first.

Do:

- Ask a parent or bigger person first when someone asks them to:
 - Go somewhere
 - Do something
 - Take something
- Ask first if they are unsure if something is safe.



Reinforce

This week, reinforce following the Always Ask First Rule with specific feedback:

I noticed Doug asked Teacher Lee first before taking the snack Zach offered him. That is following the Always Ask First Rule.
