As part of our tree study the students and the teachers worked together to make apple sauce. When completed everyone tried the finished product! MMMM MMMM GOOD!

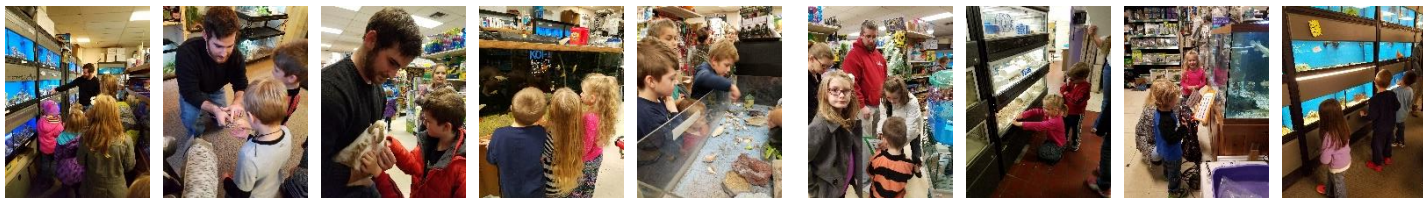


# Conemaugh Township Center is off to a great start!!
